

POST PROCEDURE

Discharge Advice

You have just been discharged following your procedure, during which you were administered sedative drugs. These may cause ongoing drowsiness or clumsiness and the following advice is extremely important.

1. FOR THE NEXT 24 HOURS YOU MUST NOT:

- Drive any vehicle or operate machinery
- Make any important decisions (particularly ones requiring signing of legal documents)
- Drink alcohol

2. YOU MUST HAVE A RESPONSIBLE ADULT STAY WITH YOU OVERNIGHT

- If this cannot be organised, then please inform the staff so that alternative arrangements (such as hospital admission) can be made

CONCERNS POST PROCEDURE

If you experience any of the following symptoms, please seek medical advice:

- Bleeding or black bowel actions
- Chest or abdominal pain
- Vomiting of blood
- Weakness or dizziness
- Any other symptoms of concern
